If an applicant is accepted to AESA Prep Academy, an official transcript and medical record will be obtained by AESA with the transfer occurring between AESA Prep Academy and the student's current school. AESA will contact the applicant's current school upon receiving parental permission and then AESA Prep Academy would become the student's school of record.

If the student applicant applies in the summer, they obviously will not be required to shadow.
