AESA courses are based upon the standards of The National Council of Teachers of Mathematics, Next Generation Science Standards, The National Council of Teachers of English and The National Council for History Education. AESA courses are also NCAA approved.

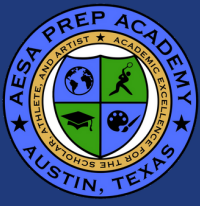
AESA Students 9th - 12th grade sit for Fall and Spring final exams. Grades are based on a 4.0 GPA scale with no additional weight for Dual-credit courses. Students must earn a 70% or higher to receive credit for a course. AESA only ranks students as required by Texas state-funded universities and recognizes the Valedictorian and Salutatorian.

AESA supports Seniors, Juniors and exceptional Sophomores and Freshmen, to distinguish themselves academically through dual-credit courses from The University of Texas at Austin, The University of California at Berkeley, The University of Wisconsin, Austin CC. AESA does not offer AP courses or IB courses but accepts them when students transfer in.

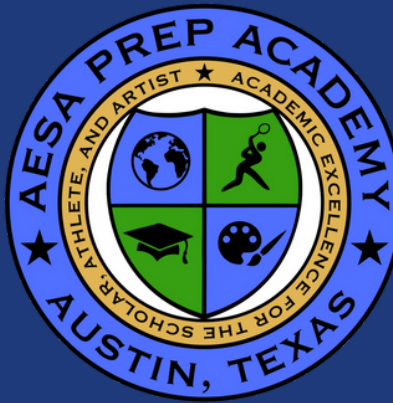
2022-2023 School Profile
